

NO PARTY POLICY

We have a strict no party policy. We reserve the right to immediately evict guests if a party is reported. Random inspections may be conducted in the event of a neighbor complaint. Please keep noise to a minimum as you are holidaying in a residential area. Please bring guests and music inside with closed windows by 10pm.

AFTER-HOURS ASSISTANCE

Please contact 0474 359 891 for after-hours emergencies. This includes lockouts and urgent repairs. A \$100 charge will be processed on your card for lockouts out-of-hours. Please call our office the following business day for all other enquiries.

KFYS

All keys are logged out via our borrowing system. If keys are missing upon checkout, charges will apply for cutting/changing of locks.

Guests must not attempt to break in to premises if locked out.

BBQs

BBQs are provided at some properties only. Please report if your BBQ condition is unsatisfactory upon arrival. A \$50 BBQ clean charge applies if the plates or trays are left dirty. Should you run out of gas during your stay you can swap-n-go your gas bottle at the local service station and keep your receipt for reimbursement from our office.

CLEANING

Any reports of unsatisfactory cleaning must be reported to our office <u>upon arrival</u>. Guests are expected to leave the property tidy as per the guests departure checklist guidelines

RUBBISH

Your property should have signage indicating which bin day for each coloured bin. and what items that you dispose. If you cannot locate this please visit www.clarence.nsw.gov.au/Residents/Waste-and-recycling/Bins-and-collections. A bin collection fee may be charged for excessive rubbish or for bins not placed on kerb on appropriate day. Please remove all rubbish from inside the property placing in bins prior to your departure as per the Guest Departure Checklist.

ANIMALS


With the exception of our pet friendly properties and service animals, dogs and other animals are not permitted at the premises. This includes visitors pets and animals visiting for a day trip. Any cleaning or pest treatment costs incurred due to an animal being brought to the property will result in a guest charge. For pet friendly properties- please ensure to remove all evidence of your pet as these properties are also enjoyed by non-pet lovers.

LOST PROPERTY

If lost property is found you will be contacted and you have 14 days to claim. Items able to be returned via postage be sent at your expense or via collection from our office reception.

ACCIDENTAL DAMAGES

Departure Checklist

- Turn off all lights & appliances (excluding fridges) and lock all doors and windows
- Ensure all belongings are taken with you- check all areas







YAMBA & ANGOURIE

At the mouth of the Clarence River Yamba is the coastal destination that dreams are made of. The town's beaches are blissful, with world-beating surf breaks and marine parks that brim with dolphins, sea turtles and migrating whales – all enveloped by national parks and wilderness reserves. And the town's thriving dining and shopping scene is sure not to disappoint.

MACLEAN

Self-proclaimed as 'The Scottish Town of Australia', Maclean is enveloped by fields of sugarcane and farmland. Spend your day exploring it's charmed-filled streets, fishing off the riverbank or taking the scenic walk to the Maclean Lookout that boasts unrivaled views over the entire Clarence Valley.

GRAFTON


At the heart of the Clarence Valley region lies Grafton, an historic town lined with glorious architecture, on the banks of the Clarence River, containing an array of shopping and cafes. Famous for its striking array of lacaranda trees and its vibrant arts scene.

UIMARRA

Small in population but big in personality, Ulmarra delivers country swagger and quirky cool in equal measure. On the banks of the Clarence River, the former port town boasts a particularly well-preserved collection of heritage-listed buildings, many of which now house stores and galleries. Spend the day exploring the many antiques stores searching for that rare collectable or have lunch at the Ulmarra Hotel.

WOOLL

Set on a narrow three-kilometre peninsula, the tiny town of Wooli is practically an island Just a 40min drive south Iluka, life here revolves around the water, whether you're surfing, swimming and fishing, or cruising around the immense Solitary Islands Marine Park. The peaceful Wooli River also make it ideal for kayaking and paddle-boarding.





SHORT TERM RENTAL ACCOMODATION (STRA)

The NSW Government has implemented a new statewide regulatory framework for short-term rental accommodation (STRA). It sets out the legal responsibilities and compliance approach for hosts, letting agents, guests and booking platforms.

Guests are to abide by the following requirements:

Guests to act lawfully

A guest must not engage in conduct in their capacity as a guest that contravenes:

- (a) the criminal law
- (b) planning laws or by-laws (if the premises are in a strata or community scheme) that apply to the premises
- (c) the terms of a short-term rental accommodation arrangement for the premises.

Obligations to neighbours

A guest must not at any time during the occupancy period:

- (a) create noise that because of its level, nature, character, or quality, or the time it is made, is likely to harm, offend, or unreasonably disrupt or interfere with the peace and comfort of neighbours and other occupants of the premises
- (b) act in a violent or threatening manner towards neighbours or other occupants of the premises
- (c) act in a manner that could reasonably be expected to cause alarm or distress to neighbours and other occupants of the premises
- (d) use or enjoy the premises in a manner, or for a purpose, that interferes unreasonably with the use or enjoyment of common property by neighbours and other occupants of the premises in a strata or community scheme
- (e) intentionally, recklessly or negligently cause damage to premises, any common property or any other communal facilities within the immediate vicinity of the premises, or any public property in the vicinity of the premises
- (f) intentionally, recklessly or negligently damage the personal property of neighbours of the premises or other occupants of a strata or community scheme.
